The Planets into the Signs

Sun

The Planets into the Houses

Sun in 11th House

The Qualities and Elements

The signs of the zodiac are grouped into two basic categories. These are known as the Qualities and the Elements. The Qualities describe fundamental modes of activity and the Elements describe temperament. There are three Qualities: Cardinal, Fixed & Mutable and four Elements: Fire, Air, Earth & Water. Your horoscope has varying degrees of each Quality and Element. The percentages you have of each will determine their importance in your life. The Qualities

8% Cardinal

Moon Conjunct Jupiter (0°03' S)

Moon Trine Saturn (4°47' A)

Mercury Conjunct Mars (7°41' A)

Ascendant = Sun/Venus (-1°09' S)

An attractive and affectionate personality; 'getting what you want in life' by turning on the charm. A sweet and lovable nature. Sensuality. Loving partnerships; sexual attraction and compatibility. An artistic and aesthetic sense. Image and fashion conscious. Wanting to 'look good' - especially when seen out or in public. An active social life.

Ascendant = Sun/Pluto (+0°15' A d)

Midheaven = Mars/Neptune (+1°22' A)
