# **The Qualities and Elements**

The signs of the zodiac are grouped into two basic categories. These are known as the Qualities and the Elements. The Qualities describe fundamental modes of activity and the Elements describe temperament. There are three Qualities: Cardinal, Fixed & Mutable and four Elements: Fire, Air, Earth & Water. Your horoscope has varying degrees of each Quality and Element. The percentages you have of each will determine their importance in your life. The higher percentages will be more powerful in your life, the lower percentages will be less powerful.

### **The Qualities**

### 8% Cardinal

The Cardinal signs are Aries, Cancer, Libra & Capricorn. The more planets you have in any of these signs the more Cardinal you are:

Cardinal people are action oriented and initiating. They are interested in promoting change and bringing new things into the world. They are direct, assertive and like to take charge of situations. They are ambitious, independent and dislike being supervised. They are good at starting projects, but not so good at completing them. They have abundant enthusiasm and are very resourceful. ### 58% Fixed

The Fixed signs are Taurus, Leo, Scorpio & Aquarius. The more planets you have in any of these signs the more Fixed you are:

Fixed people are persevering and enduring. They achieve results in life through determined and persistent effort. They tend to do one thing at a time and are extremely practical in their approach to everything. They are not easily influenced by others and can be quite firm or stubborn once their minds are made up about something. They tend to hold onto things and are reluctant to change. ### 33% Mutable

### 33% Fire

### Sun = Saturn/Neptune (-0z59' S)

Fluctuating levels of vitality, motivation and initiative. Recycling periods of decreased physical strength and stamina. Psychosomatic illnesses. Acknowledging the value of maintaining a healthy diet and lifestyle. Innate sensitivity. Susceptibility to inner and external influences. Spiritual aspirations and practices. A sacrificing nature.

### Sun = Mercury/Neptune (-0z56' S d)

Imaginative and creative thinking and writing. The ability to become inspired. Instinctive decision making. Receptive and perceptive. Compassionate. Idealistic objectives. Easily influenced. Gullibility.

Secretive. Evasive. Tendency to lack clarity of thought. Misunderstandings and misconceptions. Confusion and disorientation. Nervous exhaustion.

### Sun = Neptune/Moon's North Node (+0z09' A)

Inspiring others and being inspired. Sensitivity and empathy within relationships. Connections with spiritual, healing or idealistic groups. An occasional lack of confidence in the company of others. Unrealistic expectations of other people. Disappointments within associations.

### Moon = Jupiter/Neptune (-1z56' S)

A sensitive and compassionate nature. Receptive to spiritual, religious or philosophical subjects. Metaphysical interests. Psychic perception. Trusting and having faith. Idealistic and imaginative qualities. Believing anything is possible; the potential for taking risks without considering the consequences. Feelings of disappointment. Susceptible to the effects of intoxicants and stimulants. Evasive and escapist tendencies.

### Moon = Sun/Mars (+0z18' A d)

A self-motivated individual who gets results. Acting as a protector and provider - hard working and productive. A dominant figure in domestic, family and relationship affairs. Taking care of others and taking charge of situations. Marriage and procreation. Emotional reactions to conflict, aggressive energy or pushiness.

### Moon = Neptune/Midheaven (+0z23' S d)

An empathic and easily inspired individual. Trusting personal instincts and feelings about things. Receptive to spiritual and psychic influences. ### Saturn = Venus/Moon's North Node (-1z25' A d)

Idealistic aspirations. Visionary qualities. An interest in spiritual matters. Psychic sensitivity. Meditation. A sensitive physique and constitution. Fragility. Decreased vitality and physical strength. Bouts of exhaustion and depleted energy. Difficulty sustaining a course of action. Vocational instability. Elusive or escapist tendencies.
